ADMISSION PROCEDURES FOR THE DOCTOR OF AUDIOLOGY (Au.D.)**

Application Deadlines

March 1 – Applications for the following Fall Semester

NOTE: Students applying to the audiology program are only admitted in the Fall Semester.

Required Material

1. Completed Application form (designate Audiology as your intended major field).
2. Scores from the Graduate Record Examination (GRE).
3. Official Transcripts from all schools attended.
4. A written statement describing why you wish to enter the Au.D. program.
5. Three letters of recommendation from individuals familiar with your academic and clinical work.

Admission Procedures

1. Admission to the graduate program in audiology is competitive. Only 10 students are admitted a year in audiology. Accreditation standards will not allow this department to exceed this number of students.
2. All required materials must be received and processed by the department application deadline before your application will be considered. Students should plan to take the GRE so that the Graduate School will receive the scores before the stated deadline.
